## KOODAIDERI RAIL PROJECT - Miscellaneous Earthworks

**Ground-breaking work on a new mine development**

The proposed Rio Tinto Koodaideri Mine and associated rail infrastructure have required significant preliminary works in order to aid project planning and approvals. Carey were awarded the contract to complete the miscellaneous earthworks associated with the rail development; principal work for which was the clearing of 180km of trace line for the proposed new railway line.

In addition Carey completed:

- Construction of new and upgrading of existing access tracks
- Construction of laydown areas adjacent to railway line



- Installation of heritage fencing and modifying existing fence lines to suit
- Build drill pads for geotechnical and water bore investigations
- Test pitting works
- Dust Management

Working closely with the EPCM contractor ensured the works were completed within the allotted timeframe. Positive recognition was received for the quality of work and also the accommodating nature of the site team.
