NAMMULDI BELOW WATER TABLE PROJECT – Earthworks and Miscellaneous Services Contract

Working with one of our key clients to extend the life of their mine

The Nammuldi mine life extension, achieved through the Nammuldi Below Water Table Project, required the construction of a vast array of new infrastructure, including the construction of a new accommodation camp village and associated facilities. Carey was awarded the Earthworks and Miscellaneous Services Contract in November 2011 for the construction of buildings and utility pads, surface and underground drainage and general civil construction associated with the Camp.



- Grouted Rip rap installation
- Construction of an Environmental Pond
- Subgrade Preparation and Final Trim for Concrete Pads
- 8Ha of Site Rehabilitation



Due to the constraint of the available work areas, contractors were required to work in very close proximity to each other. Excellent relationships and constant coordination was required with other contractors to ensure a successful completion. The success of the Nammuldi Project at Brockman 4 led to Carey Mining to being awarded additional works at Brockman 2.

Works include:

- 14Ha of Clearing works & Topsoil Stripping
- 75,000m³ Cut to fill/Waste
- Various Drainage and Stormwater works including V-drains, culverts and catch pits
