# RIO TINTO IRON ORE - Crushing and Screening of Low Grade Ore

An ongoing civil service contract built on consistent, quality outputs

Carey was awarded an initial contract at Paraburdoo in 2010 for the crushing and screening of 1,500,000t of low grade ore. On the back of the successful project, Carey was awarded further screening works at both Paraburdoo and Tom Price in addition to other earthmoving and civil tasks around the mine site.

Carey's scope included:

- Loading, haulage, crushing and screening of ore
- Minesite rehabilitation seeding
- General material loading and haulage



The works have at times required 24 hour operations, supplying 3 different products at a target of 96,000m<sup>3</sup> per month. On all set projects, Carey has achieved completion of the scope within the allocated timeframes.
